

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Breckenridge:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses of the town of Breckenridge, in the county of Summit and state of Colorado, for and during the fiscal year beginning on the first day of April, A. D. 1897, and ending on the 31st day of March, A. D. 1898, the following amounts, to-wit:

For Salary account.....	\$1600 00
For street lighting.....	1000 00
For fire department.....	200 00
For interest on redemption fund.....	1300 00
For water works.....	1000 00
For incidental expenses.....	250 00
For streets, alleys and bridges.....	300 00

Sec. 2. Provided should there be in any fund more than is necessary or required for the purpose of such fund, the surplus may by an order of the Board of Trustees (to be entered upon the records of their meetings,) be devoted to such purpose or purposes as may to said Board of Trustees seem best.
