

Our Ordinance

To amend Sec. 13 article 3. of the ordinances of the Town of Brockton, entitled "Offences affecting the public peace, and to repeal said sections."

Section 1

If any person shall, within the limits of this town make or countenance, or assist in making any improper noise, or disturbance, or breach of the peace, by challenging any person to fight, or threatening to fight or fighting any person, except in necessary self defence or shall be guilty of violent or offensive conduct tending to provoke a breach of the peace. Every such person shall on conviction be fined in a sum not less than three nor more than two hundred dollars.

Section 2

All ordinances in conflict with section one of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
