

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ANNUAL  
APPROPRIATIONS.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of  
the Town of Breckenridge.

Sec. 1—That there be and hereby is appropri-  
ated for the purpose of defraying the necessary  
expenses of the Town of Breckenridge in the  
County of Summit and State of Colorado for  
and during the fiscal year beginning on the first  
day of April A. D. 1901 and ending on the 31st  
day of March A. D. 1902. The following amount  
to wit:

For salary account.....	\$1800
For street lighting.....	1200
For Fire Department.....	500
For water works.....	1000
Incidental expenses.....	250
Street alleys and bridges.....	1000

Sec. 2.—Provided; should there be in any  
fund more than is necessary or is required for  
the purpose of such fund. The surplus may by  
an order of the Board of Trustees, to be reserved  
upon the records of their meetings, be devoted  
to such purpose or purposes as may to said  
Board of Trustees seem best.

Sec. 1. That from the fund hereby is appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses of the Town of Monticello in the County of Summit and State of Colorado for and during the fiscal year beginning on the first day of April A. D. 1901 and ending on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March A. D. 1902 the following amounts to wit

For Salary Board	1800 <sup>00</sup>
For Street Lighting	1700.00
For Fire Department	500.00
For Water Works	1000.00
For Incidental Expenses	750.00
For Streets, alleys and Bridges	1000.00

Section 2. Provided should there be in any fund more than is necessary, or is required for the purpose of such fund, the surplus may by an order of the Board of Trustees "to be entered upon the records of their meetings" be devoted to such purpose or purposes as may to said Board of Trustees seem best
