

An Ordinance Concerning Tax Levy
Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of
the Town of Breckenridge.

Section 1. There shall be levied upon all the
taxable property of the Town of Breckenridge,
in the County of Summit and State of Colorado,
for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1903 a
tax of five (5) mills on the dollar, for the main-
tenance of the water-works system for said Town;
and there shall be levied upon all the taxable
property in said Town of Breckenridge, for the
fiscal year ending March 31, 1903 a tax of
five (5) mills on the dollar to be placed in the
General fund, so that said General fund may
equal the annual appropriation and current
expenses of said Town.

Section 2. Such taxes shall be collected as other
taxes are collected, and shall be placed in the
same proportion as levied to the Credit of the
Water Works fund of said Town and to the Credit
of the General fund, for the purpose of de-
fraying the expense of said Town.

Section 3. Such tax so collected shall be and
remain inviolable for maintaining said wa-
ter works system and said current expenses:
Provided, however, that should there be at any
time more money in said water works fund
than is necessary for said purpose, or should
there be more money in said General fund
than is necessary to meet said expenses
of said Town, the surplus in either fund
or both funds may, by an order of the

Board of Trustees of said Town of Breckenridge,
(said order to be entered upon the records of their
Meeting; to be placed to the Credit of other funds
or it may be devoted to such special purposes
as to the Board of Trustees may seem best.

the Board of Trustees of the Town of Brecken-
ridge, Colorado
