

The Ordinance concerning annual appropriations was read as follows

An Ordinance concerning annual appropriations.
Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Greeneridge,
Section I. That there be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of paying
the necessary expenses of the town of Greeneridge, in the County of Summit
in the State of Colorado, for and during the fiscal year beginning on the
first day of April A. D. 1904, and ending on the 31st day of March A. D. 1905
the following amounts to wit;

\$100 Salary account	\$1800.00
\$100 Street lighting	850.00
\$100 Fire Department	500.00
\$100 Water Works	500.00
\$100 Incidental Expenses	750.00
\$100 Streets, Alleys & Bridges	1000.00
\$100 Water Works Sinking Fund	1500.00

Section 2. Provided should there be in any fund more money than is
necessary or is required for the purpose of such fund, the surplus may
by an order of the Board of Trustees, (to be entered upon the records of their
meeting,) be devoted to such purpose or purposes as may to said Board
of Trustees seem best.

Passed and approved this 11th day of March, A. D. 1904, at an adjourned
meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Greeneridge, Colorado.
