

An Ordinance Concerning Public Health, was introduced and read in full, after which it was read and adopted section by section, and was then read as a whole, Passed and adopted, by the following Vote Ayes, Alber Galloway Knorr and Mr Cides.

Ordinance Concerning Public Health
Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge.

Section 1st Every female inmate of any bawdy house, house of ill fame or place for the practice of Prostitution or lewdness within the Town of Breckenridge or within three miles from the limits of said Town shall appear before and be examined by the Town Physician of said Town at least once each week and if found by said Physician after such examination to be free from any and all venereal diseases, the said Town Physician shall issue unto such female a certificate signed by him as such Town Physician stating that the holder thereof, has been examined by him, giving the date of such examination and that he found from such examination, that she was free from all venereal diseases.

Section 2

any female being an inmate of any bawdy house, house of ill fame or place for the practice of Prostitution or lewdness within the Town of Breckenridge or within three miles of the limits of said town without having such certificate shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and

on conviction shall be fined not less than five Dollars nor more than fifty Dollars.

The Town Physician shall receive a fee of One $\$1.50$ for each examination which shall be paid by the person examined which fees shall be in addition to the salary of said Town Physician.

The Board of Trustees of said Town shall prepare a form and furnish to said Town Physician blanks certificates to be used by said Physician in carrying out the provisions of this Ordinance.

The first examination shall take place under this ordinance not later than the 15th day of July A.D. 1904.

Nothing in this Ordinance contained shall in any manner be construed as licensing, condoning or countenancing bawdy houses, houses of ill fame or places for the practice of prostitution or lewdness within said town or within three miles from the limits of said town and in no wise or manner conflicting with any Ordinance of said town or statute of the State of Colorado now in force in reference to prostitutes bawdy houses, houses of ill fame or places for the practice of prostitution or lewdness.

This Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.

Passed and approved this 5th day of July 1904^{AD} at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge Colorado.
