

Mayor Hauser called the meeting to order and announced the business of the meeting was for the purpose of adopting an Ordinance for the government of the Cemetery.

Ordinance concerning the government Regulation and Care of Cemeteries was introduced after reading the same in full. it was read and adopted section by section and was then read as a whole.

Trustee McAdoo moved that the Ordinance be adopted as read, motion being second. The roll being called showed the following Vote. Ayes Trustees Alber Fletcher Gillowsay Knorr McAdoo Weaver. Motion prevailed. The Ordinance declared Adopted.

An Ordinance
Concerning the government Regulation and Care of Cemeteries
Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge

Section 1st

That the Map of Breckenridge Cemetery as acknowledged by William McAdoo as Mayor and now on file in the Office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Summit County, be and the same is hereby declared to be a Map of Breckenridge Cemetery, and that sections lots and divisions, streets and Alleys as designated and shown on said Map are hereby declared to be fixed and determined beyond alteration, except by Ordinance of the Board of Trustees and then only so far as not to interfere with private rights, subject nevertheless to the lotting, subdividing and numbering such portions of said grounds as have not already been lotted and numbered.

Section 2nd

The disposal of the lots in Breckenridge Cemetery shall be under the control of a Committee of three members of the Board of Trustees to be known as the Committee on Cemetery subject to such rules

book to be kept for that purpose by the Town Recorder and when so executed and recorded shall vest and the title absolutely in the grantee his heirs and assigns subject to such prudential rules and regulations as the Board of Trustees may from time to time adopt. All Conveyances heretofore made and so executed and recorded are hereby declared to be binding and valid.

Section 3rd

The care and management of Breckenridge Cemetery shall be vested in said Committee on Cemetery which said Committee shall have full control and management of said Cemetery and of the sexton thereof subject at all times to the supervision and direction of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge.

Section 4th

The Board of Trustees shall appoint in the same manner as other officers are appointed, a Sexton, said sexton shall hold his Office during the pleasure of the Board of Trustees and shall receive such Compensation as the Board of Trustees shall direct. The Sexton of the Cemetery under the direction of said Committee shall have the Control and Management of the Cemetery, as to the laying out and subdividing of the same, and the clearing up and improving of the ground and the ornamentation thereof. Shall have charge of all interments made in said Cemetery and shall receive as compensation for digging a grave filling the same, and for attendance at the burial Five Dollars for each person interred to be paid by the party procuring the service.

Section 5th

All moneys derived in any manner from the Breckenridge Cemetery shall be paid to the

expenditure of this fund for the improvement of the Cemetery, but they shall not incur any liability nor create any debt which can not be fully paid or discharged by the fund then on hand, without first having submitted full and specific plans of the improvements contemplated to the Board of Trustees for their approval and if approved by the Board of Trustees the said Board of Trustees shall thereupon order a transfer to the Cemetery fund upon the town records of a sum sufficient to meet such expenditures

Section 6th

No burial shall be permitted in the Cemetery until the party applying shall furnish the Town Recorder the name, sex, nativity, age, cause and date of death of the person to be buried if known to such applicant and the said Town Recorder shall keep a record of such report together with the date of burial and the number of the grave, and lot upon which such interment was made, forms and blanks for which shall be furnished by the Board of Trustees

Section 7th

No person shall ride or drive in said Cemetery ground faster than a walk, nor ride or drive on other than the laid out avenues in said Cemetery, under the penalty of Five Dollars for each and every offence

Section 8th

No burial shall hereafter be permitted upon any lot in said Cemetery unless the grave shall be dug full six (6) feet deep from the lowest part of the rim of said grave

Section 9th

The price of said lots shall be Ten Dollars for a full lot, Five Dollars for one half lot and Three Dollars for single grave and

are and they are hereby repealed
Section 11

This Ordinance shall be and remain in full
force and effect from and after its adoption
