

An Ordinance concerning levying a tax upon the taxable property of the Town of Breckenridge and providing for ordinary revenues thereof

Be it Ordained, by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge,

Section I. There shall be levied upon all of the taxable property of the Town of Breckenridge in the County of Summit State of Colorado, for the fiscal year ending the thirty first day of March A.D. 1906, a tax of One and  $9/10$  Mills on the dollar, for the maintenance of the Water Works system of said Town, and there shall be levied upon all of the taxable property of the said Town of Breckenridge for the fiscal year ending the thirty first day of March A.D. 1906, a tax of seven and  $1/2$  Mills on the dollar, to create a Sinking fund for the redemption of the outstanding Water Works Bonds.

and there shall be levied upon all of the taxable property of said Town of Breckenridge for the fiscal year ending the thirty first day of March A.D. 1906, a tax of  $\frac{75}{100}$  of one mill on the dollar for the improvement <sup>and maintenance</sup> of the Cemetery of said town.

Section 2. Such tax shall be collected as other taxes are collected and shall be placed in the same proportion as levied, to the credit of the water works fund of said town, and to the credit of the sinking fund for the redemption of the water works bonds, and to the credit of the Cemetery fund, for the improvement and maintenance of the Cemetery of said town and when collected shall remain inviolable for said purposes, provided however that should there be at any time more money in said water works fund than is necessary for said purposes, or should there be more money in said sinking fund than is necessary for the redemption of said bonds, the surplus in either fund, or both funds may, by an order of the Board of Trustees of said Town of Breckenridge the said order to be entered upon the records of their meeting be placed to the credit of other funds, or it may be devoted to such special purposes as the Board of Trustees may see best.

Passed and approved this 5<sup>th</sup> Day of March, A.D. 1905 at an adjourned regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge in the State of Colorado
