

An Ordinance Concerning annual Appropriation

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge

Section I That there be and hereby is appropriated for the purposes of paying the necessary expenses of the Town of Breckenridge in the County of Summit in the State of Colorado for and during the fiscal year beginning on the first day of April A.D. 1905 and ending on the thirty first day of March A.D. 1906. the following amounts to wit:

- Salary account \$ 2,000.00
- Street Lighting Account 850.00
- Fire Department Account 500.00
- Water Works Account 500.00
- Incidental Account 250.00
- Streets Alleys and Bridges Account \$ 1,000.00
- Water Works Sinking Fund Account 1,500.00

Section 2 Provided should there be in any fund more money than is necessary or is required for the purpose of such fund, the surplus may by order of the Board of Trustees (to be entered upon the records of their meeting) be devoted to such purpose or purposes as may to said Board of Trustees seem best.

Passed and approved this 8th day of March A.D. 1905 at an adjourned regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge Colorado
