

The following Ordinance was now read, to wit:-

On Ordinance
 Laying a tax upon the taxable property of the town of Greeridge, and for providing for the ordinary revenues thereof.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Greeridge:-

Section I:- There shall be levied upon all the taxable property of the town of Greeridge, in the county of Summit, State of Colorado, for the fiscal year ending the thirty-first day of March, A.D. 1907, a tax of $\frac{9}{10}$ mill on the dollar, for the maintenance of the water works system of said town, and there shall be levied upon all the taxable property of the said town of Greeridge, for the fiscal year ending the thirty-first day of March, A.D. 1907, a tax of $\frac{7}{2}$ mills on the dollar to create a sinking fund for the redemption of outstanding water works bonds, and there shall be levied upon all of the taxable property of said town of Greeridge, for the fiscal year ending the thirty-first day of March, 1907, a tax of $\frac{3}{5}$ of a mill on the dollar for the improvement and maintenance of the cemetery of said town.

Section 2:- Such tax shall be collected as other taxes are collected, and shall be placed in the same proportion as levied to the credit of the water works fund of said town, and to the credit of the sinking fund for the redemption of the water works bonds, and to the credit of the cemetery fund for the improvement and maintenance of the cemetery of said town, and when collected shall remain inviolable for said purpose. Provided, however, that should there be at any time more money in said water works fund than is necessary for said purposes, or should there be any more money in said sinking fund than is necessary for the redemption of said bonds, the surplus in either fund or both may, by an order of the Board of Trustees of said town of Greeridge (the said order to be entered upon the records of their meeting), be placed to the credit of other funds, or it may be devoted to such special purpose as the Board may deem best.

Passed and approved this 6th day of March, A.D. 1906, at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Greeridge in the State of Colorado.
