

The following Ordinance was now read

An Ordinance concerning annual appropriations

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Greeridge:-

Section I. - That there be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of paying the necessary expenses of the Town of Greeridge, in the County of Summit in the State of Colorado, for and during the financial year beginning on the first day of April, A.D. 1906, and ending on the thirty first day of March, A.D. 1907, the following amounts, to wit:-

Salary account,	7000.00
Street Lighting account,	850.00
Fire Department account,	500.00
Water Works account,	500.00
Incidental account,	750.00
Streets Alley and Bridges account,	1000.00
Water works, Six Ring fund account,	7500.00
Sanitary Account	500.00

Section 2:- Provided should there be in any fund more money than is necessary or is required for the purpose of such fund, the surplus may, by Order of the Board of Trustees (to be entered upon the records of their meeting), be devoted to such purpose or purposes as may to said Board of Trustees seem best.
