Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees  
of the Town of Breckenridge

Sec I

That there be and hereby is appropriated for  
the purpose of paying the necessary expenses of the  
Town of Breckenridge in the County of Summit  
State of Colorado for and during the fiscal  
year beginning on the first day of April A.D. 1908  
and ending on the thirty-first day of March A.D. 1909  
the following amounts. To-wit:

Street Lighting Account	850 00
Fire Department	500 00
Water works	500 00
Streets Alleys and Bridges	1 000 00
Water Works Sinking fund	2 500 00
Cemetery Fund	500 00
Incidental Expenses	250 00

Provided should there be in any fund more money than  
is necessary or is required for the purpose of such  
fund the surplus may by order of the Board of  
Trustees (to be entered upon the records  
of their meetings) be devoted to such purpose  
or purposes as may to the said Board of  
Trustees seem best.

Sec. I was read again, and on motion, the  
was adopted, by the following vote Ayes  
Trustees Bergman Dearing Fry Foote McAdoo  
Nays none

Section II was then read, and on motion  
was adopted, by the following vote Ayes  
Trustees Bergman Dearing Fry Foote McAdoo  
Nays none

It was then moved and seconded that the Ordinance  
be adopted as a whole, motion carried by the  
following vote Ayes. Trustees Bergman, Dearing  
Fry, Foote and McAdoo. Nays none
