

An Ordinance Laying a Tax upon the Taxable Property  
of the Town of Breckenridge, and Providing for the  
Ordinary Revenues thereof was then read in full as  
follows

Be It Ordained, by the Mayor and Board of  
Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge,

Sec I

That there shall be levied upon all the taxable  
property of the Town of Breckenridge in the County  
of Summit, State of Colorado for the fiscal  
year ending the thirty first day of March A.D. 1909,  
a tax of One and 9/10 mills on the dollar for the  
maintenance of the water works system of said town

and there shall be levied upon all the taxable property of said town of Breckenridge for the fiscal year ending the thirty first day of March A D 1909 a tax of seven and  $\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the dollar to create a sinking fund for the redemption of outstanding water works bonds. And there shall be levied upon all of the taxable property of said town of Breckenridge for the fiscal year ending the thirty first day of March A D 1909 a tax of  $\frac{3}{5}$  of a mill on the dollar for the improvement and maintenance of the cemetery of said town.

Sec II. Such tax shall be collected as other taxes are collected and shall be placed in the same proportion as levied to the credit of the water works fund of said town and to the credit of the sinking fund for the redemption of the water works bonds and to the credit of the Cemetery fund for the improvement and maintenance of the Cemetery of said town and when collected shall remain inviolable for said purposes. Provided however that should there be at any time more money in said water works fund than is necessary for said purposes or should there be any more money in said sinking fund than is necessary for the redemption of said bonds the surplus in each fund or both may by an order of the Board of Trustees of said town of Breckenridge (the said order to be entered upon the records of their meetings) be placed to the credit of other funds or it may be devoted to such special purposes as to the Board may seem best.

Section one of the above ordinance was then read and on motion the same was adopted, by the following vote Ayes Trustees Bergman, Dearing, Fry, Foote, McAdoo, Nayer, none.

Section II was then read, and on motion the same was adopted by the following vote, Ayes Trustees Bergman, Dearing, Fry, Foote, McAdoo, Nayer, none.

It was then moved and seconded that the Ordinance be adopted as a whole. Motion carried by the following vote Ayes Trustees Bergman, Dearing, Fry, Foote, McAdoo, Nayer, none. Passed and approved this Third Day of March A D 1908 at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees
