

The following ordinance establishing a tax levy for town purposes for the fiscal year ending March 31st 1910, was now introduced, and read the same being in words and figures, as follows, to-wit:

Be it ordained by The Mayor and Board of Trustees of the town of

Specimenridge.

Section I. There shall be levied upon all the taxable property of the town of Specimenridge in the County of Summit and State of Colorado, for the fiscal year ending March 31st A.D. 1910, a tax of one and 9/10 mills on the dollar for the maintenance of the water works of said town, and there shall be levied upon all the taxable of said town of Specimenridge for the fiscal year ending the thirty-first day of March A.D. 1910, a tax of seven and one half mills on the dollar to create a sinking fund for the redemption of outstanding water works bonds. And there shall be levied upon all the taxable property of said town of Specimenridge for the fiscal year ending the thirty-first day of March, A.D. 1910 a tax of three-fifths (3/5) of a mill on the dollar for the improvement and maintenance of the cemetery of said town.

Section II. Such tax shall be collected as other taxes are collected and shall be placed in the same proportion as levied, to the credit of the water works fund of said town, and to the credit of the sinking fund for the redemption of the water works bonds, and to the credit of the cemetery fund for the improvement and maintenance of the cemetery of said town and when collected shall remain inviolable for said purposes, provided however that should there be at any time more money in said sinking fund than is necessary for the redemption of said bonds, or should there be more money in said cemetery fund than is necessary for the improvement and maintenance of the said cemetery, the surplus in each fund shall, may by order of the Board of Trustees of said town of Specimenridge (the said to be entered upon the records of their meeting) be placed to the credit of other funds, and may be devoted to such other special purposes as the Board may deem best.

Section I. of the above ordinance was then read, and upon motion of Trustee McAdoo, seconded by Trustee Fote the same was adopted by the following vote, Ayes, Trustees Gurnheimer, Fote, Fry, Kite, McAdoo and Wally. Nays, none.

Section II. of the above ordinance was then read and upon motion of Trustee Fote, seconded by Trustee McAdoo the same was adopted by the following vote, Ayes, Trustees Gurnheimer, Fote, Fry, Kite, McAdoo and Wally. Nays, none.

Trustee McAdoo now moved that the ordinance be adopted as a whole, the motion being seconded by Trustee Fote, was carried by the following vote, Ayes, Trustees Gurnheimer, Fote, Fry, Kite, McAdoo and Wally. Nays, none.

Passed and approved this 20th day of March, A.D. 1909, at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the said town of Specimenridge, County of Summit, State of Colorado.
