

The following ordinance establishing a tax levy for term purposes for the fiscal year ending March 31st 1911, was now introduced and read the same being in words and figures as follows, to-wit:

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Buckenidge.

Section I. There shall be levied upon all the taxable property of the Town of Buckenidge, in the County of Summit and State of Colorado, for the fiscal year ending March 31st A.D. 1911, a tax of 1.9 mills on the dollar for the maintenance of the water works for said town, and there shall be levied upon all the taxable property of said town for the fiscal year ending the thirty-first day of March A.D. 1911, a tax of seven and one half mills on the dollar to create a sinking fund for the redemption of outstanding water works bonds. And there shall be levied upon all the taxable property of said town for the fiscal year ending the thirty-first day of March A.D. 1911, a tax of three fifths (3/5) of a mill on the dollar for the improvement and maintenance of the cemetery of said town.

Section II. Such tax shall be collected as other taxes are collected and shall be placed in the same proportion as levied to the credit of the water works fund of said town, and to the credit of the sinking fund for the redemption of the water works bonds, and to the credit of the cemetery fund for the improvement and maintenance of the cemetery of said town, and when collected shall remain inviolable for said purposes, provided however that should there be at any time more money in said water works fund than is necessary for said purposes, or should there be any more money in said sinking fund than is necessary for the redemption of said bonds, or should there be more money in said cemetery fund than is necessary for the improvement and maintenance of the said cemetery, the surplus in each fund or all, may by order of the Board of Trustees of said Town of Buckenidge (the said order to be entered upon the records of their meeting) be placed to the credit of other funds, or it may be devoted to such other special purposes as to the Board may seem best.

Section I of the above ordinance was then read, and upon motion of Trustee Fay, seconded by Trustee Kirk, the same was adopted, by the following vote, Duncan, Fay, Kirk, Walz and Bunkerlin voting aye, nay, none.

Section II of the above ordinance was then read, and upon motion of Trustee Bunkerlin, seconded by Trustee Duncan, the same was adopted by the following vote, Duncan, Fay, Kirk, Walz and Bunkerlin voting aye, nay, none.

Trustee Duncan then moved to adopt the two sections as a whole, seconded by Kirk, which was carried by the following vote, Duncan, Fay, Kirk, Walz and Bunkerlin voting aye, nay, none.

Passed and approved 1st day of March A.D. 1910, at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the said town of Buckenidge, County of Summit, State of Colorado.
