

The ordinance creating the annual appropriations for the various funds necessary for the yearly expenses of said town was now presented and read, it being in words and figures as follows, to wit:

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the

Town of Buckenidge:

Section I. That there be and is hereby appropriated for the purposes of paying the necessary expenses of the Town of Buckenidge in the County of Summit and State of Colorado, for and during the fiscal year beginning on the first day of April, 1910 and ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1911, the following amounts, to wit:

Salary account	\$2,500
Street lighting "	1,000
Fire Department "	500
Water Works "	500
Sheds, alleys and bridges account	1,500
County Fund "	500
Incidental Expense "	250

Section II. Provided, however should there be in any fund more money than is necessary for the purposes of such fund the surplus may by order of the Board of Trustees (each order to be entered upon the records of their meeting) be devoted to such other purpose or purposes as may be said Board of Trustees deem best.

Section I of the above ordinance was then read, and upon motion of Trustee Wally, seconded by Trustee Dunham, the same was adopted by the following vote: Duncan, Fry, Dunham, Wally, Kirt, voting aye, nays, none.

Section II of the above ordinance was then read, and upon motion of Trustee Kirt, seconded by Trustee Wally, the same was adopted by the following vote: Duncan, Fry, Dunham, Wally and Kirt voting aye. Nays, none.

Trustee Kirt then moved that said section be adopted as a whole, seconded by Wally, and was adopted by the following vote: Duncan, Fry, Kirt, Wally and Dunham voting aye nays, none.

Passed and approved this 1st day of March A.D. 1910, at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Buckenidge, County of Summit and State of Colorado.
