

The following is the foregoing ordinance as passed and approved.

An Ordinance

Be it ordained by The Mayor and Board of Trustees of The Town of Breckenridge, in Summit County, Colorado.

Section I That there be and hereby is appropriated for the purposes of paying the necessary expenses of The Town of Breckenridge, in the County of Summit and State of Colorado, for, and during the Fiscal Year beginning April 1st A. D. 1911 and ending March 31st A. D. 1912, the following amounts, to-wit:

Salaries Account	3000.00
Street Lighting Account	1000.00
Town & Police Account	750.00
Water Works Account	1000.00
Streets, Alleys & Bridges Account	1000.00
Construction Fund Account	100.00
Printing & Stationery Account	100.00
Education Expense Account	300.00
Interest on Warrants Account	3600.00
Interest on Bonds Account	500.00
Weights & Measures Account	100.00
Miscellaneous Expense Account	300.00

Section II Provided however, should there be in any Fund more money than is necessary for the purposes of such Fund, the surplus may by order of The Board of Trustees of The Town of Breckenridge (such order to be entered upon the records of their meeting) be devoted to such other purposes as may to said Board of Trustees of The Town of Breckenridge seem best.
