

The following is the foregoing Ordinance as passed and approved.

An Ordinance

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge, Summit County, Colorado.

Section I. There shall be levied upon all the taxable property of the Town of Breckenridge, in the County of Summit and State of Colorado, for the Fiscal Year ending March 31st A.D. 1911, a tax of Two (2) mills on the dollar for the maintenance of the Water Works of said Town; and there shall be levied upon all the taxable property of said Town of Breckenridge for the Fiscal Year ending March 31st A.D. 1911, a tax of Seven and one half (7 1/2) mills on the dollar to create a Sinking Fund for the redemption of out standing Water Works Bonds; and there shall be levied upon all the taxable property of said Town of Breckenridge for the Fiscal Year ending March 31st A.D. 1911, a tax of One-half (1/2) of a mill on the dollar for the improvement and maintenance of the Cemetery of said Town; and there shall be levied upon all the taxable property of said Town of Breckenridge for the Fiscal Year ending March 31st A.D. 1911, a tax of Five (5) mills on the dollar for the General Fund of said Town for the redemption of out standing General Funds warrants.

Section II. Said Taxes shall be collected as other Taxes are collected, and shall be placed in the same proportion as levied to the credit of the Water Works Fund of said Town, and to the credit of the Sinking Fund for the redemption of Water Works Bonds, and to the credit of the Cemetery Fund for the improvement and maintenance of the Cemetery of said Town, and to the credit of the General Fund for the redemption of out standing General Funds warrants; provided however that should there be at any time more money in said Water Works Fund than is necessary for said purpose, or should there be more money in said Sinking Fund than is necessary for the redemption of said Bonds; or should there be more money in said Cemetery Fund than is necessary for the improvement and maintenance of said Cemetery; or should there be more money in said General Fund than

is necessary for the redemption of out standing General Funds warrants, the surplus in said Fund - or all - may, by order of the Board (the said order to be entered upon the records of their meeting) be placed to the credit of other Funds, or it may be devoted to such other special purposes as the Board may deem best.
