

Reading of - An Ordinance
 Creating the Annual Appropriation
 for the fiscal year ending March 31st A.D. 1914

Be it ordained: By the Mayor and Board
 of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge
 in the County of Summit and State of Colorado

Section 1 That there be and hereby is
 appropriated for the purpose of paying
 the necessary expenses of the Town of Breckenridge
 in the County of Summit and State of Colorado
 for and during the fiscal year ending March
 31st A.D. 1914 the following amount: To wit:

Salaries acct	3000.00
Street Lighting "	1000.00
Water Works "	1000.00
Streets, Alley, Bridges, Etc	1000.00
Tire & Police "	250.00
Cemetery Fund "	100.00
Printing Stationery "	200.00
Election Expense "	300.00
Interest on Warrants "	500.00
" " Bonds "	500.00
Weights & Measures	100.00
Miscellaneous Expense "	300.00
Public Health "	\$ 300.00

Section 2 - Provided However: That should
 there be in any fund at any time more money
 than is necessary for the purpose of such fund
 the surplus, may, by order of the Board of
 Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge (such order
 to be entered on the records of their meeting)
 be devoted to such other purposes as may to said
 Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge
 seem best
