

An Ordinance
Creating the Annual Tax Levy for the Town of
Breckenridge, Colorado, for the fiscal year ending
March 31st 1915, And providing for the transfer
of Funds

Be it ordained, by the Mayor and the Board of Trustees
of the Town of Breckenridge, in the County of Summit
and State of Colorado.

Section 1:— That there shall be levied upon all taxable
property in the Town of Breckenridge, Summit County,
Colorado, for the fiscal year ^{ending} March 31st A.D. 1915,
the following taxes upon each dollar of valuation, to wit:—

For the Maintenance of the Water Works of said Town.

One cent. Mill

For a Sinking Fund Four 0.04. Mills

For a Cemetery Fund One eighth 0.0125 Mills

For the General Fund Two and 1/2 0.025 Mills

Section 2: Said Taxes shall be collected as all other taxes
are collected, and shall be placed in the same proportion as
levied to the credit of the Water Works Fund of said Town, and
to the credit of the Sinking Fund for the redemption of outstand-
ing Water Works Bonds; and to the credit of the Cemetery Fund
for the improvement and maintenance of the Cemetery of said
Town, and to the credit of the General Fund for the redemption
of outstanding General Fund Bonds:

Provided However, That should there be at any time
more money in the said Water Works Fund than is necessary
for the said purpose, or should there be at any time more
money in the Cemetery Fund than is necessary for the improvement
and maintenance of said Cemetery, or should there be at any
time more money in the General Fund than is necessary for
the redemption of outstanding General Fund Bonds: any
such surplus in either of said funds, may by order of the
Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge (said order
to be entered upon the records of their meeting) be placed to
the credit of other funds or it may be devoted to such other
special purposes as the Board may by order direct.

Town of Breckenridge, County of Summit and State of
