Creating the Annual Appropriations
for the Fiscal Year ending March 31st A.D. 1916

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees
of the Town of Breckenridge Colorado

Section (1) That there be and hereby is
Appropriated for the purposes of Paying
the necessary expenses of the Town of
Breckenridge Colorado for and during the
Fiscal Year ending March 31st A.D. 1916

that should there be in any fund at any
time more money than is necessary for
the purposes of such fund the surplus
may by the order of the Board of Trustees
of record be devoted to such purposes and
transferred to such other accounts as may
and proper
