

Amending Section (4) of the Ordinance of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge Concerning the Issuing of Licenses - Published Peddler's & Hawker's found on Page 33 34 & 35 of the revised Ordinances of the Town of Breckenridge - Published in A.D. 1890

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge Colorado

Section (1) That section (4) of the Ordinance of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge Concerning the Issuing of Licenses. Published Peddler's & Hawker's found on Page 33 34 35 of the revised Ordinances of the Town of Breckenridge published in 1890 read as follows

Where Not Applicable

Section (4) The foregoing sections shall not be construed as to apply to any person or persons carrying into the town of Breckenridge with leaves ~~and~~ otherwise for the purpose of selling "Vegetables, Fruits, Berries or other food products" provided

That said Vegetable, Fruits, Berries or other food products were grown or raised by the person or persons so having them for sale and are products of the State of Colorado

Also the foregoing sections shall not be construed as to apply to any person or persons selling only Bibles or the publication of any Bible tracts or other religious works

Mills Annotated Statutes A.D. 1912

Section (7226) Powers of City Council and Board of Trustees Paragraph 2nd Page 304

(A) To license for sale of one's own products

It shall be unlawful for any city or incorporated town in the State of Colorado whether incorporated under general law or special charter to impose by ordinance or otherwise any license assessment or

Other charge upon any person, bringing
 food products to such City or Town for sale
 either in Bulk or retail from house to house
 provided — said food products were grown
 or raised by the person or persons so having
 them for sale and are products of the State
 of Colorado
