

Ordinance

Ordering the construction of a Sewer System in the first Public Sewer District in the Town of Prosser, Colorado and further adopting Plans and Specifications and providing for the assessment and payment of the costs thereof; deciding the Town Clerk to advertise for Bids therefor and finding that proper and legal notice was given and that no objections were made and etc.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Prosser, Colorado:

Sec. 1. That there is hereby ordered constructed in the First Public Sewer District, in the Town of Prosser, Colorado, a sewer system in accordance with and agreeable to the plans and specifications set forth in Section Two of this Ordinance.

Sec. 2. That the plans and specifications for the said sewer system shall be as follows, to wit:

No. 1. A sewer shall be constructed from a point on High Street, down Lincoln Ave to the Blue River as stated on the ground, which is more specifically shown by the maps herewith, and from which laterals shall be run between Main St. and to and including the East side of High Street between Washington and Carter Corners.

Sec. 2. All trenches shall not be less than five feet in depth from the surface and deeper when necessary, as shown by the vertical section, herewith, or built on the grades as furnished by the town engineer and the same shall be wide enough to properly lay the tiling therein, not less than two feet wide; the town engineer shall have the right at any and all times to direct the laying of the said tiling in said trenches and the same must be laid according to his direction, on the grades and to the depths the said engineer shall designate from time to time.

No. 3. There shall be laid in Lincoln Corner between stations 1 and 2 as designated on the Map herewith 329.9 ft. of ten inch tiling between the stations 2 and 3, 224.5 ft. of ten inch tiling, between stations 3 and the Blue River 1107.13 ft. of twelve inch tiling, a portion of the latter shall be laid on Main Street, as shown by the map, all which shall be laid in Portland Cement with tight joints, subject to the acceptance of the said Town Engineer. On High Street there shall be laid in the same manner above described 497 feet six inch tiling, as shown by maps herewith. On Main Street there shall be laid in the same manner above described 604 feet of six inch tiling, as shown by the maps herewith. On the Alley between Harris and High Street there shall be laid in the same manner above described 365 feet of six inch tiling, as shown by the maps herewith. On the Alley west of Public School Bldg. there shall be laid in the same manner as heretofore described 420.9 ft. of six inch

Tiling, as shown on the map herewith.

On French Street there shall be laid in the same manner heretofore described 375.7 feet of six inch tiling as shown on the map herewith.

On ^{Ridge} French Street there shall be laid in the same manner heretofore described 762.7 feet of six inch tiling as shown on the map herewith.

No 4. All the lateral abutments amount to 3034.3 feet of six inch tiling, 554.4 feet of ten inch tiling and 1107.3 ft. of twelve inch tiling, which makes a combined length of 4696 feet or 2846 rods of trenching and filling.

No 5. There shall be placed in said sewers or laterals, as directed by the town engineer, 51 Ts and 6 inch tile to 4 inch openings

as Sanitary Ts and Vs," all of which abutments fittings is included in the estimate of the actual lengths of the various tiling, so that they may be taken to cover about two feet on the various lines instead of the tiling above specified. All of the joints and fittings above mentioned shall be laid in the same manner as described for the laying of the tiling subject to the approval of the town engineer, with the further endorsement of the Town Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Brockridge.

No 6. The trenching will average five feet in depth throughout, except that the space between stations 3 and 5 on Lincoln Ave. will average 8 feet in depth, and station one on High Street will be 7 feet deep, making the grade from said point 1 toward station A. at 5 feet towards station B 5 feet and at station 2 five feet in depth.

No 7. The estimated cost of said sewer when completed shall not exceed eight (8) mills for each square foot of lot within said described district, or the whole improvement shall not cost more than \$4,028.92 when the same has been wholly completed.

No 8. It is expressly understood that there shall be no rocks and nothing but good dirt placed in the tiling for at least one foot above the same, and no large rocks will be permitted in

the trench at all when the same is filled, but such works are not permitted on the trench must be removed from the site at the expense of the contractor. It is further understood that streets 500 and 200 feet shall be opened at any time and no distance greater than shall grant such permission in writing, which may not be for more than twenty four hours at any one time. Further that all trenches made and all pipe laid shall be covered by the contractor and at his expense and that the Town of Prockemidge will pay no expense incident to the said improvement except the contract price, and none of this may be paid until the same has been passed upon and accepted by the town engineer and the Board of Trustees of the Town of Prockemidge.

No 9. There shall be placed in position on the various lines as shown on the blue front hereinto, 5 foot lengths of stand pipe for flushing purposes, which shall be of 4 inch wrought-iron with male iron screw cap endings which shall be set into 4 inch T's, as provided in the filing with a cement joint, the top of said pipe shall be flush with the surface of the ground.

No 10.- The wages to be paid for workman employed shall not be less than \$3.00 per day of eight hours.

No 11. The end of the sewer shall be laid under water in the Blue Trench to such a depth, so that it will be completely covered with water at all times of the year.

Sec 3-- That the Town Clerk be and he hereby is directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said Sewer System, said advertisement to be run in the Summit County Journal for a period of ten days or two successive issues thereof.

Sec 4-- That the costs of said sewer system when completed shall be assessed to the property and the property owners included in The First Public Sewer District, and shall be due and payable within 30 days from the publication of the assessing ordinance without demand.

Sec 5-- That all previous Ordinances, Orders and Resolutions adopted by the Board of Trustees with reference to the said sewer system are hereby ratified, adopted and made part of this final sewer system ordinance.

Sec. 6-- That the Board of Trustees of the Town of Prockemidge, hereby finds that said, The First Public Sewer District was duly created as required by law and that said improvements and construction of said sewer system was duly ordered after notice duly given to the property owners of property included in the said Sewer District,

And further finds that no protests in writing were filed to the
 construction of said sewer system in said District
