

AN ORDINANCE Relating to Intoxicating Liquors.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge, in the County of Summit, and State of Colorado.

Section 1. No person, association or corporation shall within this Town, manufacture for sale or gift any intoxicating liquors; and no person, association or corporation shall bring into this town any intoxicating liquors for sale or gift; and no person, association or corporation shall within this town sell or keep for sale any intoxicating liquors, or offer any intoxicating liquors for sale, barter or trade, except for medicinal and sacramental purposes and then only in manner and form as provided by the laws of the State of Colorado relating thereto.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or member of any club, society or association or for any proprietor, manager or employee of any hotel, restaurant, rooming house, boarding house or any place of public entertainment, in this town, to keep, aid or abet in keeping, any intoxicating liquors for the purpose of sale or gift as a beverage or for the division or distribution of the same about any such place in any manner whatsoever. In all cases arising under the provisions of this section, any person above specified shall be a competent witness to prove a violation of any of the provisions hereof, and no such person shall be excused from testifying by reason of such testimony tending to incriminate himself, but the testimony so given shall in no case be used against himself.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, association or corporation to solicit or take any order or orders for or any purchase or purchases of intoxicating liquors in any manner whatsoever, except for medicinal and sacramental purposes as in this ordinance and the laws of the State of Colorado provided.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry on or about his person, or for any person, association or corporation to engage or employ any other person to so carry, in any quantity, any intoxicating liquors for the purpose of selling, bartering, giving away, or illegally delivering the same.

Section 5. Any person, association or corporation violating any of the provisions of this act shall, upon conviction, be fined in a sum of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment in the Town Jail of not less than thirty days and not more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the police magistrate.

Section 6. For the purpose of enforcing this ordinance and the laws of the State of Colorado concerning intoxicating liquors, the Town Marshal of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado, is hereby designated as the officer of this town intrusted with the duty of enforcing this ordinance and the laws of the State of Colorado within this Town.
