

AN ORDINANCE
Creating the Annual Appropriation for the Fiscal Year Ending March 31st, 1917.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO:

SECTION 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of paying the necessary expenses of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado for and during the fiscal year ending March 31st, 1917, the following amounts and for the following purposes to wit:

For Salaries Account, the sum of \$3,000.00.

For Street Lighting Account, the sum of \$1,250.

For Water Works Account, the sum of \$1,500.00

For Streets, Alleys and Bridges, the sum of \$1,500.00.

For Fire and Police Account, the sum of \$250.00.

For Cemetery Fund the sum of \$250.00.

For Printing and Stationery Account, \$200.00.

For Election Expenses, the sum of \$300.00.

For Interest on Warrants Account, the sum of \$500.00.

For Weights and Measures Account the sum of \$100.00.

For Miscellaneous Account (Expenses) the sum of \$300.00.

For Public Health Account, the sum of \$300.00.

SECTION 2. Provided, however, that should there at any time be in any fund more money than is necessary for the purposes of such fund, the surplus may, by order of this Board duly made and entered of record, be devoted to such other purposes and transferred to such other accounts as may to said Board seem expedient and proper.
