

AN ORDINANCE
Regulating the speed of automobiles and motorcycles, regulating the traffic thereof and imposing a penalty for violation in the same.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE:

Section 1. That the speed limit of automobiles and motorcycles within the town of Breckenridge is hereby fixed at a speed not to exceed fifteen miles per hour.

Section 2. That it shall be the duty of all persons who drive or ride automobiles or motorcycles within the corporate limits of the town of Breckenridge to sound an appropriate warning of their approach at all corners and crossings.

Section 3. That it shall be the duty of all persons who drive or ride automobiles or motorcycles within the corporate limits of the town of Breckenridge to keep to the right-hand side of the street, and when turning corners to keep to the outside thereof.

Section 4. That any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, on conviction, be fined in a sum not less than Five Dollars and not more than One Hundred Dollars.

Section 5. That it shall be the duty of the City Marshal and all other persons possessing power conferred by the ordinances of this city to arrest any person who may be found violating the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 6. That all ordinances or acts or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
