

AN ORDINANCE
Concerning the Issuance of Licenses
for Automobiles Kept for Hire and
Establishing the Rate Thereof

Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to operate or maintain an automobile livery within the corporate limits of the Town of Breckenridge, or to solicit trade upon the streets thereof without first having obtained a license therefor from the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the said Town of Breckenridge.

Section 2. That no license shall be granted for said purpose for a shorter period than six months, and that the annual rate thereof shall be ten (\$10) dollars for the first or single automobile and five (\$5) dollars for each additional automobile so kept, maintained and operated.

Section 3. That any person or persons who shall operate or maintain an automobile livery as hereinbefore specified without first having obtained a license therefor, as herein set forth shall forfeit and pay to the town, for each offense, the sum of twenty-five (\$25) dollars.
