

AN ORDINANCE

Creating the annual tax levy for the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado for the fiscal year ending March 31, A. D. 1917, and providing for the transfer of funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF COLORADO:

SECTION 1. That there shall be levied upon all the taxable property in the Town of Breckenridge, Summit County, Colorado, for the fiscal year ending March 31, A. D. 1917, the following taxes upon each dollar of valuation, to-wit:

For the maintenance of the water works of said town, four (4) mills.

For a Cemetery Fund, One-Sixth (1-6) Mills.

For the General Fund, Ten and 5-6 (10 5-6) Mills.

SECTION 2. Said taxes shall be collected as all other taxes are collected, and shall be placed in the same proportion as levied to the credit of the Water Works Fund of said Town, and to the credit of the Cemetery Fund for the improvement and maintenance of the Cemetery of said Town, and the credit of the General Fund for the redemption of outstanding General Fund Warrants:

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that should there be at any time more money in the said Water Works Fund than is necessary for said purpose, or should there be at any time more money in said Cemetery Fund than is necessary for the improvement and maintenance of said Cemetery, or should there be at any time more money in the General Fund than is necessary for the redemption of outstanding General Fund warrants: any such surplus in either of said Funds, may, by order of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge, (said order to be entered upon the records of their meeting), be placed to the credit of other funds, or it may be devoted to such other special purposes as the Board may by order direct.

PASSED AND APPROVED, this 9th day of November, A. D. 1916, at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Trustees in the Town of Breckenridge, Summit County, Colorado, there being a quorum present.
