

Second reading of Ordinance concerning Powers held  
An Ordinance

Declaring the necessity of widening certain portions  
of Lincoln Ave. in the Town of Breckenridge,  
Summit Co. Colo. and the exercise of the right of  
Eminent Domain for the taking of  
Private Property Therefor.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of  
Breckenridge - Summit Co. Colo.

Sec I. That portion of Lincoln Ave. extending  
westward from main st. to the junction of Staley St.  
in the Town of Breckenridge - Summit Co. Colo. Co.,  
and the same is hereby declared to be in an  
unsafe, dangerous, and unsatisfactory condition for  
Public use.

Sec II. That it is hereby declared necessary that  
certain parts of said portion of said Lincoln Ave. be  
widened in order to put the same in a safe and  
satisfactory condition for public use.

Sec III. That it is hereby declared necessary, in order  
to widen Lincoln Ave. as aforesaid, that the Town of Breckenridge take and  
appropriate, by the exercise of the right of Eminent  
Domain, the following described private property, to wit:  
Mining Claim Number Eighty Four and one half 84 1/2  
Bartlett and Shock Places. Addition to the Town of  
Breckenridge, Summit Co., Colo.

Sec IV. That the Officers and authorities of the Town  
of Breckenridge be, and they are hereby authorized  
and directed to take what ever further and additional  
action in the premises as may be necessary and  
appropriate.
