

An Ordinance

Creating the Annual Tax Levy for the Town of  
Breckenridge, Summit County, Colorado, for the Fiscal  
Year ending March 31<sup>st</sup> A. D. 1920 and providing for  
the transfer of Funds.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the  
Town of Breckenridge:

Section 1: That there shall be levied upon all the  
taxable property in the Town of Breckenridge, Summit  
County, Colorado, for the Fiscal Year ending March 31<sup>st</sup>  
A. D. 1920, the following taxes upon each dollar of valuation  
to-wit:

For the maintenance of the State Roads of  
said Town One (1) Mill.

October 26, 1918

For the General Fund Thirteen (13) Mills.  
For a Special Improvement Fund One (1) Mill.

Section 11: Said Taxes shall be collected as all other Taxes are collected and shall be placed in the Fund of said Town, to the credit of the State Taxes Redemption of our outstanding General Fund Warrants, and to the credit of the Special Improvement Fund to defray a portion of the expense incident to the widening of that portion of Lincoln Avenue extending Westward from Main Street to 7th Street in said Town of Breckenridge;

Provided However: There should there be at any time more money in the said State Taxes Fund than is necessary for said purpose, or should there be at any time more money in the General Fund than is necessary for the Redemption of our outstanding General Fund Warrants, or should there be at any time more money in the Special Improvement Fund than is necessary to defray the expense incident to widening said portion of Lincoln Avenue, then such surplus in either of said Funds may by order of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge (said order to be entered upon the records of their meetings) be placed to the credit of other funds, or it may be devoted to such other special purpose as the Board of Trustees may by order direct.

Passed this 26<sup>th</sup> day of October A. D. 1918 at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Trustees of said Town of Breckenridge, held in the Town of Breckenridge, Summit County, Colorado. There being a quorum present.
