

An Ordinance relating to the licensing of Automobiles kept for hire, was now presented and read by the Clerk: It was moved by Tommie Canning that the Ordinance relating to the licensing of Automobiles be adopted and approved as read: Seconded by Tommie Francis: The motion being put carried unanimously and was so ordered: The following is the Ordinance as approved and adopted:-

An Ordinance concerning the issuance of Licenses for Automobiles kept for hire, establishing the rate therefor, and repealing all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge,

Section I: That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep, operate, or maintain an Automobile for hire within the corporate limits of the Town of Breckenridge, or to solicit trade for the purpose aforesaid upon the streets of the said town of Breckenridge, without first having obtained a license therefor from the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the said Town of Breckenridge.

Section II: That no license shall be granted or issued for said purpose for a shorter period than One year, and that the annual rate thereof shall be Ten (\$10.00) dollars, payable on the 1st day of

May 6, 1919.

January of each and every Calendar year, for each and every Automobile or street, maintained, or operated.
Section III: That every person or persons who shall keep, operate, or maintain an Automobile for hire, or collect traffic as herein before specified, without first having obtained a license therefor as herein set forth shall forfeit and pay to the Town of Brookenside, for each offense, the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars.

Section IV: That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
