

AN ORDINANCE


ESTABLISHING WASHINGTON AVENUE AS A THROUGH STREET
AND AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS AT
CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS ALONG SAID STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, SUMMIT COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. That from and after the date of this
ordinance Washington Avenue in the Town of Breckenridge,
during the months of November, December, January, Febru-
ary and March, shall be a through street from French
Street to Main Street.

Section 2. That there shall be erected at the inter-
section of Washington Avenue and Ridge Street stop signs
on the North and South sides of Washington Avenue on
Ridge Street, and that there shall be erected at the
intersection of Washington Avenue and Main Street stop
signs on the North and South sides of Washington Avenue
on Main Street.

Section 3. That all other ordinances or parts of
ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING WASHINGTON AVENUE AS A THROUGH STREET
AND AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS AT
CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS ALONG SAID STREET.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, SUMMIT COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. That from and after the date of this ordinance Washington Avenue in the Town of Breckenridge, during the months of November, December, January, February and March, shall be a through street from French Street to Main Street.

Section 2. There shall be erected stop signs on Ridge Street at its intersection with Washington Avenue and there shall be erected stop signs on Main Street at its intersection with Washington Avenue. All vehicular traffic shall be required to make a full and complete stop at the intersections where said stop signs are placed during the months of November, December, January, February and March.


Section 3. Any person who unlawfully violates the provisions of this act shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period of not less than ten days nor more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. That all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
