

ORDINANCE NO. ONE

Series of 1953

AN ORDINANCE FIXING RATES AND CHARGES FOR CONNECTIONS WITH AND THE USE OF THE SEWER AND SEWAGE SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO:

Section 1. There shall be levied and collected in the manner hereinafter provided, the following amounts, from any person connecting with or using the sewage system of the Town of Breckenridge, for such connection and use, and such rates and charges are hereby found and determined to be just, reasonable and necessary in order to properly provide for the repair, maintenance and extension of the said sewage system of the said Town of Breckenridge:

- (a) One family residence unit, the sum of \$25.00.
- (b) For a business establishment, not a hotel, rooming house or motel, and in which is conducted one business only, the sum of \$35.00.
- (c) For each hotel, rooming house or motel, the sum of \$25.00, plus an additional sum of \$10.00 for each unit or room located therein, in which a bathroom is provided, and the additional sum of \$15.00 for each bathroom provided for the joint use of occupants of the said hotel, rooming house or motel.
- (d) For multiple dwellings, the sum of \$25.00, plus the additional sum of \$15.00 for each additional family unit.
- (e) For multiple business units, the sum of \$35.00, plus the sum of \$10.00 for each additional business in excess of one such business located on the said premises.


Section 2. No connection shall be made to the sewage system of the Town of Breckenridge unless the sums fixed above shall have been first paid to the Town Clerk of the Town of Breckenridge, the receipt for which shall constitute the permit of the individual paying the said sum to connect with and use the said sewage system.

Section 3. In the event that any person or persons shall connect with the said sewage system from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, without first obtaining a permit therefor, collection of the charges herein above provided for shall be made as provided in Section 3, Chapter 221, Session Laws of Colorado, 1937.


Section 4. Funds received by the Town Clerk in payment for the connection with and use of the said sewage system, shall be placed in the Treasury of the Town and kept in a separate fund, and shall be retained therein and expended only in accordance with the provisions of Section 2, Chapter 221, Session Laws of Colorado, 1937.

Section 5. In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge, an emergency exists; therefore, this Ordinance shall be and become effective and shall be in force immediately upon its passage, adoption and publication.
