

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE

Dedication of Lot 8, Block 8 of the Edmund G. Stiles Addition to the Town of Breckenridge as a Street Known as a Continuation of Washington Avenue

An Ordinance relating to the Dedication by the Town of Breckenridge of Lot 8, Block 8 of the Edmund G. Stiles Addition to the Town of Breckenridge, for the purpose of dedicating the said lot as a street which will in effect be a continuation of Washington Avenue directly west of Main Street in the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Breckenridge, County of Summit, State of Colorado:

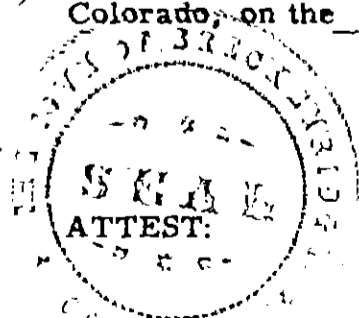
Section 1. That Lot 8, Block 8 of the Edmund G. Stiles Addition to the Town of Breckenridge as the same is recorded in the Clerk and Recorder's Office, County of Summit, State of Colorado, and which is located directly west of Main Street and is hereby made a continuation of Washington Avenue, shall and is hereby dedicated as a street in the Town of Breckenridge and for the use of the public.

Section 2. The said dedication has been deemed necessary in order that Washington Avenue as it runs directly west of Main Street may be widened to a practical width.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official Town paper, Summit County Journal.
