

ORDINANCE No. 2

Series 1964

An Ordinance adopting the budget for the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning on the 1st day of January, 1965, and ending on the last day of December 1965, estimating the amount of money necessary to be raised by tax levy based on the said budget so adopted; estimating the amount of money to be derived from other revenue sources; and setting forth the total estimated expenditures for each fund.

WHEREAS, Frank F. Brown, the person designated to prepare the annual budget for Breckenridge, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1965, and ending December 31, 1965, has prepared said budget and submitted it to the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees held a public hearing on said budget on November 8, 1964; and

WHEREAS, the assessed valuation of taxable property for the year 1964 in the Town of Breckenridge, as returned by the County Assessor of Summit County, Colorado, is the sum of \$ 830,545.⁰⁰.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the budget for the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1965, and ending on

December 31, 1965, as heretofore submitted to the Board of Trustees by the Town Clerk, and as changed and amended by said Board of Trustees be, and the same hereby is adopted and approved as the budget for the Town of Breckenridge for said fiscal year.

Section 2. That the budget herein approved and adopted shall be signed by the Mayor and the Town Clerk, and made a part of the public records of the Town.

Section 3. It is declared that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and shall be in force and effect five (5) days after publication.
