

ORDINANCE No. 3

Series 1964

An Ordinance levying taxes for the year 1964 to defray the costs of Municipal Government of Breckenridge, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1965 and ending December 31, 1965;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge has adopted a budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1965, and ending December 31, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that the proper mill levy upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town is .33 mills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purposes of defraying the expenses of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado, during the fiscal year beginning on January 1, 1965, and ending on December 31, 1965, there is hereby levied a tax of .33 mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Breckenridge for the year 1964.

Section 2. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado, the total tax levy for the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado, as is herein set forth.

Section 3. It is declared that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and shall be in force and effect five (5) days after publication.


