

ORDINANCE No. 4

Series 1964

The Annual Appropriation Ordinance: Appropriating Sums to Defray Expenses and Liabilities of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado, for the Town's fiscal year beginning January 1, 1965.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has, by ordinance, adopted a budget for the Town for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1965, and ending on the last day of December, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has, by ordinance, made the proper tax levy in mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town, such levy representing the amount of taxes for Town purposes necessary to provide for payment during the Town's said fiscal year of all properly authorized demands upon the treasury; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is now desirous of making appropriations for the ensuing fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO:

Section 1: That the following appropriations are hereby made for the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1965, and ending on the last day of December, 1965,

from the General Fund for the payment of operating expenses and capital outlay of the general government, public safety, public works, public health and contingencies:

General government	\$11,875.00
Protection	5,200.00
Sanitation	500.00
Water	20,500.00
Highway	2,100.00
Recreation	850.00
Miscellaneous	<u>4,370.00</u>
Total General Fund	\$45,395.00

Section 2: That the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Bond Interest Fund for the purpose of defraying bond interest payments for the year 1965.

Section 3: That the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) is hereby appropriated from the Bond Redemption Fund for the purpose of bond redemption for the year 1965.

Section 4: It is declared that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and shall be in force and effect five (5) days after publication.
