"AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE ALL STREETS AND ALLEYS WITHIN THE TOWN HERETOFORE DEDICATED OR HERETOFORE OR NOW USED BY THE PUBLIC WITHIN SAID TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE."


WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge that a complete formal and proper acceptance on behalf of the Town named has not heretofore been made of all the streets and alleys within the corporate limits of said Town;

WHEREAS, to clarify this situation and for other good and sufficient reasons, the Town desires to reaffirm and accept all the streets and alleys within the Town of Breckenridge heretofore dedicated or heretofore or now used by the public within said Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, SUMMIT COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. That all streets and alleys existing or heretofore existing and dedicated expressly or by implication or by law within the corporate limits of the Town of Breckenridge, used or heretofore used by the public within said Town, or capable of use by the public within said Town, are hereby accepted and deemed accepted by the Town as public streets and alleys.
