

PEOPLE'S ORDINANCE NO. 6

SERIES 1990

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO:

Section 1. There is hereby added to the Breckenridge Town Code a new Chapter 12 of Title 1, entitled "Municipal Elections", which shall read in its entirety as follows:

CHAPTER 12  
MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

Section:

1-12-1       Municipal Election Code  
1-12-2       Appointment of Election Judges  
1-12-3       Compensation of Election Judges  
1-12-4       Election Precincts; Polling Place  
1-12-5       Use of Electronic Voting Machines

1-12-1:       MUNICIPAL ELECTION CODE: Except as otherwise provided by ordinance, all municipal elections shall be held in accordance with the provisions of the Colorado Municipal Election Code of 1965, Article 10 of Title 31, C.R.S., as from time to time amended.

1-12-2:       APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION JUDGES: The Town Council delegates to the Town Clerk the authority to appoint Judges of Election for all Regular and Special elections of the Town.

1-12-3:       COMPENSATION OF ELECTION JUDGES: The judges of election at any Town election shall receive in full compensation for their services as judges of election the maximum amount allowed by state law for payment to the judge of the general election of the State of Colorado, as from time to time amended.

1-12-4:       ELECTIONS PRECINCTS; POLLING PLACE: There shall be one election precinct for all Regular and Special elections of the Town, the boundaries of which precinct shall be the same as those of the corporate limits of the Town, and the polling place for which precinct shall be the Town Hall, 150 Ski Hill Road, Breckenridge, Colorado. The absent voter polling place shall also be the Town Hall.

1-12-5:       USE OF ELECTRONIC VOTING MACHINES: The votes cast at all Regular and Special elections of the Town shall be recorded on electronic machines, except that paper ballots may be used for absentee voting. Said elections shall be held and conducted, the returns thereof canvassed, and the results thereof declared, in the manner prescribed by law for municipal elections.


Section 2. Resolution No. 6, Series 1988, adopted March 8, 1988, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. The Town Council hereby finds, determines and declares that it has the power to adopt this Ordinance pursuant to the authority granted to home rule municipalities by Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and the powers contained in the Breckenridge Town Charter.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by Section 5.9 of the Breckenridge Town Charter.

INTRODUCED, READ ON FIRST READING, APPROVED AND ORDERED PUBLISHED IN FULL this 13th day of March, 1990. A Public Hearing on the Ordinance shall be held at the regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado, on the 27th day of March, 1990, at 7:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as possible in the Municipal Building of the Town.
