AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF CLASS D DEVELOPMENT IN THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE DEVELOPMENT CODE TO INCLUDE THE INSTALLATION OF A SWIMMING POOL, HOT TUB OR SPA; AMENDING THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE BUILDING CODES ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE FEE TO BE PAID FOR A PERMIT TO INSTALL A SWIMMING POOL, HOT TUB OR SPA UNDER THE UNIFORM SWIMMING POOL, SPA AND HOT TUB CODE, 1997 EDITION; AND AMENDING THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE BUILDING CODES ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A POOL, SPA OR HOT TUB UNDER UNIFORM SWIMMING POOL, SPA AND HOT TUB CODE, 1997 EDITION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO:

Section 1. The definition of "Class D Development" as set forth in Section 9-1-5 of the Breckenridge Town Code is hereby amended by the inclusion of the following additional provision:

- Installation of swimming pool, spa or hot tub

Section 2. Paragraph (A)(1) of Section 8-1-9 of the Breckenridge Town Code, concerning the fee to paid for a permit to install a swimming pool, hot tub or spa under the Uniform Swimming Pool, Spa and Hot Tub Code, 1997 edition, as adopted by the Town of Breckenridge, is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

1. Chapter 1, Section 110.0, Fees, second paragraph, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Such applicant shall pay for each permit, at the time of making application, a fee in accordance with Table 1-A of the Uniform Building Code, 1997 edition, based upon a valuation set by the Building Official.

Section 3. Section 8-1-9 of the Breckenridge Town Code is hereby amended by the inclusion of a new paragraph (A) (5), which shall read in its entirety as follows:

5. Chapter 3, Section 319.0, Electrical, is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

319.0 Electrical

319.1 Electrical wiring and equipment shall comply with the National Electrical Code (NEC).

319.2 No aluminum conductors shall be allowed for swimming pools, spas, or hot tubs.

Section 4. Except as specifically amended hereby, the Breckenridge Town Code, and the various secondary codes adopted by reference therein, shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. The Town Council hereby finds, determines and declares that this Ordinance is necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, and improve the order, comfort and convenience of the Town of Breckenridge and the inhabitants thereof.

Section 6. The Town Council hereby finds, determines and declares that it has the power to adopt this Ordinance pursuant to the authority granted to home rule


municipalities by Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and the powers contained in the Breckenridge Town Charter.


Section 7. This Ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by Section 5.9 of the Breckenridge Town Charter.

A Public Hearing shall be held at the regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado on the 24th day of April, 2001, at 7:30 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible in the Municipal Building of the Town.




The public hearing on this ordinance was held on April 24, 2001.


