

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BRECKENRIDGE TOWN CODE CONCERNING MUNICIPAL COURT
CIVIL JURISDICTION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO:

Section 1. The introductory paragraph of Section 1-8-10 of the Breckenridge Town Code is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

1-8-10: CIVIL ACTIONS: When a violation of a municipal ordinance is alleged to exist which provides for enforcement pursuant to the provisions of this Section:

Section 2. Section 4-6-21 of the Breckenridge Town Code is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

4-6-21: PENALTY: Any person conviction of violating any provision of this Chapter shall be punished as provided in Chapter 4 of Title 1 of this Code. In addition to other remedies available to the Town, the Town may commence an action pursuant to Section 1-8-10 of this Code to enjoin the alleged violation of any provision of this Chapter.

Section 3. There is hereby added to Section 5-1-13 of the Breckenridge Town Code a new Paragraph C, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

C. In addition to other remedies available to the Town, the Town may commence an action pursuant to Section 1-8-10 of this Code to enjoin the alleged violation of any provision of this Chapter.

Section 4. There is hereby added to Section 5-3-13 of the Breckenridge Town Code a new Paragraph E, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

E. In addition to other remedies available to the Town, the Town may commence an action pursuant to Section 1-8-10 of this Code to enjoin the alleged violation of any provision of this Chapter.

Section 5. There is hereby added to Section 5-5-6 of the Breckenridge Town Code a new Paragraph C, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

C. In addition to other remedies available to the Town, the Town may commence an action pursuant to Section 1-8-10 of this Code to enjoin the alleged violation of any provision of this Chapter.

Section 6. There is hereby added to the Breckenridge Town Code a new Section 5-6-10, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

5-6-10: PENALTY: Any person convicted of violating any provision of this Chapter shall be punished as provided in Chapter 4 of Title 1 of this Code. In addition to other remedies available to the Town, the Town may commence an action pursuant to Section 1-8-10 of this Code to enjoin the alleged violation of any provision of this Chapter.

Section 7. Paragraph B of Section 9-2-1-11 of the Breckenridge Town Code is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

B. The Town Council may further institute, in addition to other remedies provided by law, such equitable proceeding, including, but not limited to, injunctions, mandamus, abatement, or other appropriate action or proceedings as may be necessary to effect compliance with the provisions of this Chapter. In addition to other remedies available to the Town, the Town may commence an action pursuant to Section 1-8-10 of this Code to enjoin the alleged violation of any provision of this Chapter.

Section 8. There is hereby added to Section 9-3-18 of the Breckenridge Town Code a new Paragraph D, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

D. In addition to other remedies available to the Town, the Town may commence an action pursuant to Section 1-8-10 of this Code to enjoin the alleged violation of any provision of this Chapter.

Section 9. Section 9-5-5 of the Breckenridge Town Code is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

9-5-5: PENALTIES: Every person convicted of a violation of any provisions of "The Handbook of Design Standards" or this Chapter shall be punished as provided in Section 1-4-1 of this Code. In addition to other remedies available to the Town, the Town may commence an action pursuant to Section 1-8-10 of this Code to enjoin the alleged violation of any provision of this Chapter.

Section 10. Section 11-5-9 of the Breckenridge Town Code is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

11-5-9: PENALTIES: Every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Chapter shall be punished as provided in Section 1-4-1 of this Code. In addition to other remedies available to

the Town, the Town may commence an action pursuant to Section 1-8-10 of this Code to enjoin the alleged violation of any provision of this Chapter.

Section 11. There is hereby added to Section 12-4-3 of the Breckenridge Town Code a new Paragraph C, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

C. In addition to other remedies available to the Town, the Town may commence an action pursuant to Section 1-8-10 of this Code to enjoin the alleged violation of any provision of this Chapter.

Section 12. Except as specifically amended hereby, the Breckenridge Town Code, and the various secondary codes adopted by reference therein, shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 13. The Town Council hereby finds, determines and declares that this Ordinance is necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, and improve the order, comfort and convenience of the Town of Breckenridge and the inhabitants thereof.


Section 14. The Town Council hereby finds, determines and declares that it has the power to adopt this Ordinance pursuant to the authority granted to home rule municipalities by Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and the powers contained in the Breckenridge Town Charter.

Section 15. This Ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by Section 5.9 of the Breckenridge Town Charter.





The public hearing on this ordinance was held on March 13, 2001.


