## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-3B-10 OF THE <u>BRECKENRIDGE TOWN CODE</u> CONCERNING THE MUNICIPAL OFFENSE OF "JOYRIDING"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 6-3B-10 of the <u>Breckenridge Town Code</u>, entitled "Joyriding", is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as follows:

6-3B-10: JOYRIDING:

Any person who drives or takes any motor vehicle without the consent of the owner or lawful possessor thereof, with the intent of temporarily depriving the owner or possessor of the use of the same, or temporarily making use thereof, commits joyriding, which is unlawful. This section shall not apply if the person's conduct constitutes the offense of aggravated motor vehicle theft in the first degree as defined by section 18-4-409(2), C.R.S., or a felony violation of the offense of aggravated motor vehicle theft in the second degree as defined by section 18-4-409(4), C.R.S.

<u>Section 2</u>. Except as specifically amended hereby, the <u>Breckenridge Town Code</u>, and the various secondary codes adopted by reference therein, shall continue in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3</u>. The Town Council hereby finds, determines and declares that this ordinance is necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, and improve the order, comfort and convenience of the Town of Breckenridge and the inhabitants thereof.

<u>Section 4</u>. The Town Council hereby finds, determines and declares that it has the power to adopt this ordinance pursuant to the authority granted to home rule municipalities by Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and the powers contained in the <u>Breckenridge Town Charter</u>.

<u>Section 5</u>. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by Section 5.9 of the <u>Breckenridge Town Charter</u>.

INTRODUCED, READ ON FIRST READING, APPROVED AND ORDERED PUBLISHED IN FULL this 26<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2008. A Public Hearing shall be held at the regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2008, at 7:30 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible in the Municipal Building of the Town.
