

The following resolution was now taken up and read;

Resolution

Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado:

First: That whereas there has been filed with the Board the petition of the owners of a majority of the frontage within the Territorial Boundaries of the First Public Improvement District of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado, asking that cement side-walks and curbing be laid on each side of the streets and avenues situated within said District and for the establishing of a grade for same.

Second: That the Town Engineer be, and hereby is directed to prepare, at the earliest time possible, full details and specifications for the grading and laying of the said cement side-walks and curbing on the said First Public Improvement District, in conformity with the petition for same and including materials to be used, an estimate of the cost of such grading and paving, together with a map of the said District, showing the approximate amount to be assessed upon each piece of property therein for and on account of such grading and paving.

Trustee Street now moved that the foregoing Resolution be approved and adopted as read: seconded by Trustee Truitt. The motion on being put carried unanimously. So ordered.

The above and foregoing Resolution was adopted by a unanimous vote of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge, Colorado, on the 6th day of July A. D. 1911. The same being one of the regular meetings of the Board.
