

A Resolution

Be it resolved by the Mayor & Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge Colorado that

Whereas there is considerable dissatisfaction with the present fire Insurance rates as applicable to the Town of Breckenridge Colorado and

Whereas it has been some eight or ten years since a readjustment or reclassification of fire Insurance Rates for the Town of Breckenridge has been made and

Whereas since such readjustment or reclassification conditions with reference to resisting fires and for suppression <sup>thereof</sup> have been greatly improved in the Town of Breckenridge and

Whereas it is the sense of this Board that the present rates are exorbitant and should be reduced.

Be it therefore resolved that we do most earnestly request the Honorable Rocky Mountain Board of Underwriters to send a representative to the Town of Breckenridge for the purpose of reclassifying the Fire Insurance

rates applicable to this Town and that such representative be instructed to make recommendations in writing along such lines as well when completed with secure better fire Insurance Rates for this Town.

The above & foregoing Resolutions were adopted by unanimous vote of the Mayor & Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge at a regular Meeting of said Board held at the City Hall on Sunday the seventh day of May A D 1912
