Condemning the Building or Cabin on Mining
Claim No (23) Bartlett & Shook Addition to the
Town of Breckenridge Colorado. Known as the
Hawkins Cabin and ordering the removal of same
from said Property

Be it, resolved by the Board of Trustees
of the Town of Breckenridge Colorado

Section (1) That Whereas there has been more or
less complaint to this Board on account of the
unsafe and unsanitary condition of the Cabin
situate on Mining Claim # 23. Bartlett and
Shook Addition to the Town of Breckenridge
and known as the Hawkins Cabin and also
considerable complaint of insulting and indecent
language used in and about the said
Cabin from time to time

Section (2) That this Board hereby finds that
the Cabin is unsafe, unsanitary, and a nuisance to
the Citizens of the Town of Breckenridge and that
same should be removed from the premises
above described

Section (3) That the said Cabin be and the same
is hereby condemned and ordered removed from the
premises above described on or before the 15th day
of June A D 1912 and the owners are hereby ordered
and directed to remove the same on or before the
above date and in case of their neglect failure
or refusal so to do the Town Marshall is hereby
ordered and directed to tear same down and remove
it from the said premises

Section (4) That a copy of these resolutions be
furnished to Breckenridge Lodge # 47 A. F. & M.
the present owner of said property

The above and foregoing Resolutions were adopted
by a unanimous vote of the Board of Trustees of the
Town of Breckenridge Colorado at a Regular
Meeting of said Board held at the Council
Chamber on Tuesday the 4th day of June A D. 1912
