

The following resolution commencing the officials of the Colorado and Southern R. R. Co. was introduced by Mayor Fincher, was read and adopted by an unanimous vote

Resolution

Whereas; For several years for some untoward reason, the People of the Town of Brockmidge have had to contend with the Colorado and Southern Railway Company for what they believed to be their rights in the way of railroad service and out of the contention grew an apparent mutual unfriendly feeling.

And whereas, through a change of the Officials of said Railway Company, that feeling seems to be entirely removed and a very friendly feeling now exists owing to the evident desire of the new officials to co-operate with the people of Brockmidge and vicinity.

Now therefore, realizing as we do the hardships incurred in maintaining service on said railroad and especially conditions as they have existed this winter, which has been the most severe in years, the people of the Town of Brockmidge, by the Town Council,

Be it Resolved, that we appreciate the efforts of the Management, Superintendent and Train crews in the maintenance of service on this Railroad, and assured the management of our hearty co-operation in any way we may be able.
