"Resolutions of Respect"

Whereas: On Nov. 7th 1918, an Epidemic which seemed to select as its prey people in the prime of life and in the zenith of usefulness also prematurely removed from our midst George W. Stale, Clerk & Recorder of the Town of Breckenridge, and

Whereas: "George Stale" had not only filled his said Office with credit, but had in other ways proved himself a useful and valuable citizen of our Community, public-spirited and always ready to serve and help his fellow-citizens, both privately and in Official capacity, therefore be it

Resolved; by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Breckenridge, in regular meeting assembled, that we make known to the breckened community our deep regret of the un-fairly death of George W. Stale and the loss of his services as Clerk & Recorder of the Town, and

Resolved; that we pay him the deserved tribute of having been an honor and a source of pride to the community and a commendable example to our rising generation, and

Resolved; that we tender to the bereft Father and other relatives of the deceased our deep sympathy in their loss, and, further

Resolved; That copies of these Resolutions be sent to the bereaved relatives, a copy placed upon the minutes of this meeting, and that these Resolutions be made known to the Community by publication in the local papers.
