A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED HOME RULE CHARTER FOR
SUMMIT COUNTY (A November 4, 1997 Countywide Ballot Question)

WHEREAS, the Town of Breckenridge has reviewed the proposed Home Rule Charter for Summit County, Colorado and has heard a presentation by members of the Summit County Home Rule Charter Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Town believes that Home Rule provides for greater local control of some governmental processes, thus better serving the interests of citizens; and






