A RESOLUTION SETTING THE FEES FOR THE USE OF THE BRECKENRIDGE GOLF CLUB

WHEREAS, the Town of Breckenridge owns and operates the Breckenridge Golf Club ("Golf Club"); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate for the Town Council of the Town of Breckenridge to set the fees for the use of the Golf Club;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO, as follows:

Section 1. Green Fees and Cart Fees. The green fees and cart fees for the Golf Club are shown on the attached Exhibit-"A", which is incorporated herein by reference. The Town Manager and Golf Professional, in consultation with the Town Council, shall determine the dates for the "High Season" and "Low Season" each year.

Section 2. Complimentary Fees. The Golf Professional may allow complimentary play at the Golf Club when he determines that the Town will realize special promotional or good will value.

Section 3. Green Fee Reduction Due to Weather or Course Conditions. The Golf Professional, with the consent of the Town Manager, may temporarily reduce the green fee whenever he determines that weather conditions and/or the condition of the course make it inappropriate to charge the normal green fee.

Section 4. Resident Card Fees. The resident card fees for the Golf Club are shown on the attached Exhibit "B", which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 5. Junior Cards, Upper Blue Cards, and Club Program Cards. The Junior Cards fees, the Upper Blue Card fees, and the Club Programs Card fees for the Golf Club are shown on the attached Exhibit "C", which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 6. Policies and Definitions. Policies and definitions regarding the use of these cards are shown on the attached Exhibit "D", which is incorporated herein by reference.


Section 7. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.



Junior Card \$200.00

For the first 32 nine hole rounds, and then \$7.50 per nine holes.

Junior Add-on Card \$75.00

Valid only after 4pm and must be purchased in conjunction with an adult card

Summit County Junior Card \$200.00

For the first 32 nine hole rounds, and then \$7.50 per nine holes.

Upper Blue Card \$280.00

For the first 16 nine hole rounds, and then \$17.50 per nine holes.

Club Programs Card \$400.00

For Ten -18 hole rounds of golf, valid only during scheduled club programs.

EXHIBIT "D"

1999 RESIDENT CARD, UPPER BLUE CARD, CLUB PROGRAMS CARD, AND JUNIOR CARD POLICIES

The following policies shall govern the purchase and use of Resident Cards, Upper Blue Cards, Club Programs Cards, and Junior Cards.

DEFINITIONS

- **Club Programs** - Are those programs administered by the golf professional and staff, and identified as Men's and Ladies Club events, and organized Junior events.
- **Current Business Licensee** - A sole proprietor, a partnership, or a corporation holding a valid business and occupational license issued by the Town under one of the following categories; **1. In-Town Business, 2. Lodge or Multiple Accommodation Units With Employees**, and who is current with all other applicable fees and taxes due the Town.
- **Junior** - Any Breckenridge or Upper Blue resident, 18 years old or younger
- **Junior Add-On** - A type of junior card purchased in conjunction with a Resident Card or Upper Blue Card, by an immediate family member. Valid after 4:00p.m. or during organized junior events.
- **Real Property Owner** - A person owning real property within the corporate boundary of Breckenridge.
- **Resident** - A person living within the corporate boundary of Breckenridge and able to provide adequate proof of residence.
- **Summit County Junior** - Any Summit County resident, 18 years old or younger.
- **Upper Blue** - An area outside the corporate boundary of Breckenridge, from Farmers Corner to the top of Hoosier Pass, which includes those housing areas between the Continental Divide and the Ten Mile Range of Mountains
- **Upper Blue Resident** - A person currently living in the Upper Blue, and who is a registered voter of an Upper Blue, Summit County precinct.

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF EVIDENCE

The Golf Professional may require evidence for any card purchase. The following shall act as proof, as well as other forms deemed acceptable by the Golf Professional:

- **Birth Certificate or Drivers License** - Proof of age for Junior Cards.
- **Business License** - Proof of valid Business License, of a business that is current with all fees and taxes due the Town, as well as tax documents or legal filings, confirming either sole proprietor, a partner of the partnership, or a principal of the corporation.
- **Real Property Tax Receipt or Deed** - Proof of ownership within the corporate boundary of Breckenridge, or Upper Blue.
- **Short Affidavit Form** - Proof of current residency in the corporate boundary of Breckenridge.
- **Voter Registration List** - Proof of residency for Breckenridge or the Upper Blue.

RESIDENT CARDS

Each qualified RESIDENT or REAL PROPERTY OWNER or CURRENT BUSINESS LICENSEE, shall be allowed to purchase a Resident Card. Only one card shall be issued for each Real Property or Current Business Licensee, although a card for each spouse will be issued to a legally married couple per each Real Property.

UPPER BLUE CARDS

Each qualified RESIDENT shall be allowed to purchase an Upper Blue Card.

USE OF RESIDENT CARDS, UPPER BLUE CARDS AND JUNIOR CARDS

Resident Cards, Upper Blue Cards and Junior Cards / Add-ons shall be used in accordance with the following conditions;

- 1) Cards are non-transferable and non-refundable and valid only for the current golf season.
- 2) Purchasers of cards must comply with all golf course policy.
- 3) Cards allow the purchaser to use the golf course Monday through Friday anytime during the day and after 1:00 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and recognized holidays, as space is available. During the season, one tee time per hour before 1:00 p.m. will be set aside for Card holders. These weekend morning tee times will require an additional fee of \$15.00 per 18 holes and rental of carts is required at these times. Cards require a fee for rounds of golf played after the initial allotment. Recognized holidays are Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day.
- 4) Card purchasers may play as a standby on Saturdays, Sundays and recognized holidays before 1:00p.m., if there is not a green fee paying customer for the tee time. Golf carts are required before 1:00p.m..

5) A Card allows the purchaser to play on Saturdays, Sundays and recognized holidays before 1:00p.m., providing the purchaser of the Card makes a tee time in advance and brings three full paying customers, or pays green fees.

6) A Junior Add-On Card is valid only after 4:00p.m., or during organized junior events.

7) Summit County Junior Cards are valid only after 3:30p.m., or during organized junior events.

8) The Town of Breckenridge reserves the right to revoke any card from the purchaser.

USE OF CLUB PROGRAMS CARD

A Club Programs Card shall be used in accordance with the following conditions;

1) Cards are non-transferable and non-refundable and valid only for the current golf season.

2) Purchasers of cards must comply with all golf course policy.

3) Cards allow the purchaser to use the golf course only during scheduled Men's Club or Ladies Club events. Men's Club events are typically played on Wednesdays, Ladies Club events are typically played on Tuesdays. Cards will only be honored during the specified block of tee times for an event date and only as space is available. Cards require a fee for each round after the initial allotment.

RESERVATION POLICY

Card holders may book tee times four days in advance on a space available basis. Tee times are accepted by telephone, or in person at the golf pro shop, starting at 7:00a.m.. Staff will accept tee times, alternating between phone calls and customers at the counter, when both conditions exist. Reservations may require a credit card number, as a form of deposit at the time of booking. Tee times for organized club programs, may be booked 7 days in advance. Only one foursome tee time may be booked per phonecall or by a customer at the counter.

RESERVATION CANCELLATION POLICY

After 2 failures to cancel or complete the group size, that has been reserved, without 24 hour notice given to the golf staff, a verbal warning will be given to the individual by the golf professional. After 1 more infraction a written letter will be sent to the individual by the Town Manager. If there is 1 more infraction after this, the individual will lose advance tee time privileges, but not Card privileges.
